



THE COMMITTEE ON TEMPORARY SHELTER (COTS)

COTS is Vermont's largest provider of shelter and services to those who are homeless or marginally housed. Our programs include three emergency shelters (2 for families and 1 for adults), two overflow shelters (1 for families and 1 for individuals), a daytime drop-in center for adults, Veterans Housing, a Housing Resource Center (at 100 North St.) that helps people secure affordable housing or hold on to what they have, social services, and transitional and permanent housing for people who have moved out of shelter or who are disabled. All facilities are located in and around downtown Burlington or Winooski.

City Market member workers can always earn hours by:

- Preparing and delivering a noontime meal for about 50 adults at the COTS Daystation, which is open 365 days a year
- Volunteering to help with the annual COTS Walk the first Sunday afternoon in May
- Calling donors or working in the mailroom during our seven-night Phonathon, held the two weeks following Thanksgiving
- Plan activities for children in Family Shelter once a week

Depending on our needs and the time of year, we also may need volunteers to help with cleaning, painting, yard work, moving furniture, mailings, transportation of clients, and activities for families in shelter.
