Third party audits are required for certifying products as Fair Trade and while there are a number of labels used to identify Fair Trade products, all organizations adhere to the Fair Trade Principles listed on the reverse side of this card. - 3. Fair Trading Practices
- 4. Payment of a Fair Price
- 5. Ensuring no Child Labor and Forced Labor
- Commitment to Non Discrimination, Gender Equity and Freedom of Association
- 7. Ensuring Safe and Healthy Working Conditions
- 8. Providing Capacity Building
- 9. Promoting Fair Trade
- 10. Respect for the Environment
