What is “Local” at City Market?

Local products at City Market are any items grown or raised in Vermont. These local products are mostly unprocessed foods like fruits and vegetables, eggs, and meat. By following our Key to Signs (pictured below) you can find local products in a variety of departments throughout the store including Produce, Bulk, Meat & Seafood, Grocery, and Prepared Foods. Our “Made in Vermont” label encompasses more value-added products like hummus, salsa, and hot sauce. These items are significantly transformed in Vermont, but the primary ingredients may not be Vermont-grown. Look for the shelf tag below to find Made in VT products.



How Does City Market Support the Local Food System?

Strengthening the local food system is part of our Global Ends, or mission statement at the Co-op. Annually, over 40% of sales are local and Made in Vermont products, demonstrating the commitment that our Members have to supporting our local farmers and producers.

In addition to carrying a variety of products, we host a vendor profile page on our website, offer a Local Farm and Producer Investment Program, highlight local products in classes and demos, host Farm Tours and Crop Mobs for the community throughout the growing season, and fund projects aimed at strengthening the local food system through our Seedling Grants program.
